(b) So far as Coffee is concerned, the steps taken by the Coffee Board are:

Grant of loans, supply of station selection seeds, demonstration plots and periodical advice to planters on cultural operations.

As regards cardamom, the Mysore Government have started a Cardamom Development Scheme with headquarters in Mercara. A research station is working in Mudigare for improvement of cardamom through research. Measures are also being taken by the Central Spices and Cashewnuts Committee to control the Katte disease.
