

## FOREIGN PRIVATE CAPITAL IN INDIAN INDUSTRIES

SHRI A. B. VAJPAYEE:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state what is the total amount of foreign private capital which the foreign collaborators invested in Indian industries during each of the five years of the Second Five Year Plan and during the first and second years of the current Plan period?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRIMATI TARKESHWARI SINHA): Information is available only for the calendar years 1956, 1957, 1958 and 1959. During these years the net amounts of foreign private capital invested in India were as under:

1956	..	Rs. 24.9 crores
1957	..	Rs. 17.9 crores
1958	..	Rs. 2.4 crores
1959	..	Rs. 10.8 crores

Information for 1960 and for the first two years of the current Plan period is not yet available.

(b) These scales were sanctioned on the basis of the recommendations of the Pay Commission in November, 1960 and were given retrospective effect from 1st July, 1959.
