EXPORT OF DRESSED MEAT TO CEYLON

*924. SHRI R. N. KAKATI: Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have taken a decision to allow free export of dressed meat from India to Ceylon; and

(b) if so, whether such export will be regulated by the Controller of Imports and Exports, Government of India, and if not, what are the reasons thereof?

THE MINISTER OF INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SHRI MANUBHAI SHAH) : (a) There is no control on the export of dressed meat from India to Ceylon.

POLITICAL OFFICERS ATTACHED TO ARMY COMMANDERS ON THE FRONTIER

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI DINESH SINGH): (a) to (c) The Political Officers are the civil administrative heads of the Frontier Divisions of the N.E.F.A. There is no system of attaching these Political Officers to the army commanders.
