

**REPLACEMENT OF ENGINES PROVIDED OF  
METRE GUAGE SECTION OF BIKANER  
DIVISION**

30. SHRI BANSI LAL: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the railway engines provided on metre gauge section in Bikaner Division are very old;

(b) if so, whether it is a fact that the passenger trains usually run late due to defects in the railway engines; and

(c) what steps Government propose to take to replace these engines?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN): (a) No. Out of a total of 178 locomotives on line in Bikaner Division, only 16 are over 45 years of age.

(b) No.

(c) These over-age locomotives are replaced ones and they will be condemned and taken off the line as and when their condition warrants.

**DIRECT TRUNK CALL SYSTEM BETWEEN

31. SHRI BANSI LAL: Will the Minister of TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state whether Government propose to introduce direct trunk call system between Delhi and Chandigarh and Delhi and Jaipur and if so, when?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI B. BHAGAVATI): Yes; between Delhi and Jaipur during 1964 and between Delhi and Chandigarh during 1966.

**NURSES TRAINING SCHOOLS in DELHI**

32. SHRI BANSI LAL: Will the Minister of HEALTH be pleased to state:

(a) the number of nurses training schools in Delhi and what is the number of seats in each of them; and

(b) whether Government propose to open some more such schools in the Capital?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH (DR. SUSHILA NAYAR): (a) There are 8 nurses training schools in Delhi and the sanctioned number of annual admissions in the first year is as under:

6. Holy Family Hospital, Okhla, New Delhi	15
7. Safdarjang Hospital, New Delhi	40
8. Hindu Rao Hospital, Delhi	6

(b) A proposal to expand the training school at the Safdarjang Hospital and to start a nurses training school in the Willingdon Hospital, New Delhi, is under consideration. The Tirath Ram Shah Hospital, Delhi, which is a private hospital, also proposes to start a training school.

**SPECIALISTS IN THE WILLINGDON AND  
SAFDARJANG HOSPITALS FOR C.H.S. SCHEME**

33. SHRI KRISHNA CHANDRA: Will the Minister of HEALTH be pleased to state:

(a) the particulars of specialist available in the Willingdon and Safdarjang Hospital; and

(b) whether specialists, both physicians and surgeons, are available for Neuro disease; if none is available, how the Contributory Health Service Scheme subscribers suffer from

Neuro disorders can get treatment or advice?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH (DK. SUSHILA NAYAR); (a) The particulars of specialists employed under the C.H.S. Scheme and posted in the Willingdon Hospital and Safdarjang Hospitals are given in the statement.

(b) Services of a Neurologist are available in the Safdarjang Hospital, New Delhi. Cases requiring investigations in Neurological fields including Neuro Surgery are frequently referred to Tirath Ram Shah Charitable Trust Hospital, Delhi, where special facilities for this purpose are available. Cases requiring advanced Neuro Surgery can be referred to any Government or recognised Hospital situated anywhere in India having the required facilities. In such cases the entire cost of treatment is met by Government. If in a particular case treatment in the Christian Medical College and Hospital, Vellore, is considered essential, arrangements are made to refer such cases to that hospital. In such cases, Government meets the expenditure to the extent of 2/3 of the cost only.
