TRANSLATION OF STANDARD WORKS OF UNIVERSITY LEVEL INTO HINDI ETC.

110. SHRI KRISHNA CHANDRA: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) the progress so far made in the scheme for preparation and translation of text-books, reference books and standard works of University level into Hindi and various regional languages; and

(b) whether any books have so far been published?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (DR. K. L. SHRIMALI): (a) Attention is invited to the reply given to Unstarred Question No. 250 on the 12th December, 1961. Following further progress has been made since December, 1961:—

1. Calcutta University has been allotted some books.

2. A Coordination Committee has been set up in Gujarat.

3. The scope of the scheme has been enlarged to include academic bodies of all-India status as well as individuals to work under the direct supervision of the Central Hindi Directorate. It has been decided to give 50 per cent financial assistance to the Universities for titles of local use chosen by them for translation into Hindi/Regional languages.

(b) A book entitled "Two Essays on Civil Government" by John Locke has been brought out by the Hindi Samiti of Uttar Pradesh under the scheme.

STIPENDS FOR THE CHILDREN OF PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS
