

ROURKELA FERTILIZER PLANT

*121. SHRI SURJIT SINGH ATWAL: Will the Minister of STEEL AND HEAVY INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the completion of the Fertilizer Plant at Rourkela is likely to be delayed; and

(b) if so, by how many months?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL AND HEAVY INDUSTRIES (SHRI C. SUERAMANIAM): (a) Attention is invited to the answer to Unstarred Question No. 145 answered on the 2nd May, 1962 in this House. It was mentioned there that the plant will go into production in September, 1962. No further delay is anticipated.

BHOJUDIH COAL WASHERY

(a) whether it is proposed to expand the capacity of the coal washery at Bhojudih; and
