*189. SHRI B. N. BHARGAVA: Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state whether it is a fact that Government are considering proposals to reduce the cost of production and the sale price of paper?]

FALL OF PLASTER IN HOME MINISTER'S RESIDENCE

*190. SHRI A. M. TARIQ: Will the Minister of WORKS, HOUSING AND SUPPLY be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a huge lump of plaster fell down recently in the bedroom of the residence of the Home Minister; and

(b) if so, whether any inquiries have been made in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF WORKS, HOUSING AND SUPPLY (SHRI MEHR CHAND KHANNA): (a) A lump of plaster fell from the roof in one of the bed rooms of the Home Minister's residence on the 17th July 1962.

- (b) No enquiry was called for in this connection. The position is that a number of bungalows in New Delhi are over 30 years old. They have jack-arch roofs or reinforced brick roofs which have outlived their life. A Committee of senior officers of the Central Public Works Department recommended some time back that major repairs, including re-roofing,

should be carried out in these bungalows. Sanction was issued for such repairs and the Central Public Works Department are carrying them out as and when the bungalows are made available for this purpose.

Per capita INCOME IN STATES

*191. SHRI CHANDRA SHEKHAR: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state the *per capita* income and the rate of increment in different States of India at the end of the First and Second Five Year Plan periods?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI DINESH SINGH): Reliable and comparable estimates of the *per capita* income of different States are not available. The Central Statistical Organisation has, however, prepared certain tentative estimates for the years 1955-56 and 1958-59 in respect of the income (at current prices) generated within the geographical area of the States in the main commodity producing sectors; the results are presented in two summary tables laid on the Table of the House. REHABILITATION COLONIES IN DELHI

*192. SHRI A. C. GILBERT: Will the Minister of WORKS, HOUSING AND SUPPLY be pleased to state:

(a) the number of Rehabilitation colonies in Delhi and by what time they will be handed over to the Municipal Corporation; and

(b) the agency which is responsible for providing basic amenities like drainage, sewage, filtered water, schools, hospitals etc. in these colonies?

THE MINISTER OF WORKS, HOUSING AND SUPPLY (SHRI MEHR CHAND KHANNA): (a) and (b) These are in all 27 rehabilitation colonies in Delhi. The provision and maintenance of services in a colony is the normal function of a local body. In the case of
