

शिक्षा मंत्री (डा० कालू लाल श्रीमाली) :

(क) समाज कल्याण निदेशालय तथा उसके अधीन संस्थाओं के लिये संभरण तथा निपटान निदेशालय के द्वारा सोलह बार सामान खरीदा गया था। संभरण तथा निपटान निदेशालय से "आपत्ति नहीं" प्रमाण-पत्र प्राप्त कर के पन्द्रह बार सामान सीधे ही खरीदा गया था। इस प्रकार का प्रमाण पत्र प्राप्त किये बिना कभी कोई सामान नहीं खरीदा गया।

(ख) जब से समाज कल्याण निदेशालय, दिल्ली, की स्थापना हुई, अर्थात् १९५८-६० से अब तक की अपेक्षित सूचना का विवरण सभा पटल पर रख दिया गया है। [देखिये पत्रिका-४०, अनुसूच सख्या ३६।]

†[THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (DR. K. L. SHRIMALI): (a) The material for the Directorate of Social Welfare and its subordinate organisations was purchased through the Directorate General of Supplies and Disposals sixteen times; it was purchased direct after obtaining 'no objection' certificates from the Director General of Supplies and Disposals fifteen times and on no occasion was it purchased direct without obtaining such a certificate.

(b) A statement containing the requisite information since 1959-60, when the Directorate of Social Welfare, Delhi came into being, is placed on the Table of the House. (See Appendix XL, Annexure No. 36.)]

PROPOSAL FOR UTILISATION OF BUILDINGS AT SHIVPURI

365. SHRI R. S. KHANDEKAR: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government are contemplating to utilise certain buildings at Shivpuri in Madhya Pradesh;

(b) if so, for what purpose they will be utilised;

(c) whether any inspection of the buildings was made by the authorities recently; and

(d) if so, what are the findings of the inspection?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI B. N. DATAR): (a) Yes. The matter is under consideration.

(b) For officers of the Central Government.

(c) and (d) Yes. The examination shows that the buildings are in quite a good condition.

†FAILURE OF STEEL PRODUCERS TO SUPPLY COMPONENTS FOR RAILWAY WAGONS ETC.

59. SHRI DAHYABHAI V. PATEL: Will the Minister of STEEL AND HEAVY INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the steel producers in the country have failed to supply components of railway wagons, locomotives and coaches manufactured in India;

(b) if so, the names of the steel plants which have failed to do so, and in view of their failure, what other arrangements Government propose to make up the deficiency; and

(c) whether this situation has affected the production of steam engines, and/or diesel engines?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL AND HEAVY INDUSTRIES (SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM): (a) and (b) Steel plants do not produce components but supply steel sections from which components are made for railway wagons, locomotives and coaches that are manufactured in the country. Presumably, the hon. Member is referring to these steel sections.
