THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN): (a) As already made known to the public it has been decided to Divisionalise the South Eastern Railway with Headquarters at Khargpur, Adra, Chakradharpur, Bilaspur, Nagpur, Waltair and Khurda Road.

- (b) Divisional Offices have already started functioning in five divisions; those at Nagpur and Waltair will be opened shortly.
- (c) The Divisional system is being introduced for better administrative control and greater operational efficiency.

PROPOSALS OF ORISSA GOVERNMENT FOR ASSISTANCE TO COOPERATIVE INSTITU-

423. Shri BAIRAGI DWIBEDY: Will the Minister of COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, PANCHAYATI RAJ AND COOPERATION be pleased to refer to the answer given to Unstarred Question No. 72 in the Rajya Sabha on the 18th June, 1962 and state:

- (a) whether the Government of Orissa has formulated any proposals for giving necessary assistance to the co-operative institutions on a more liberal pattern and submitted such proposal to the Union Government; and
- (b) if so, whether a copy of the same together with the consideration of the Government of India will be placed on the Table of the House?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, PANCHAYATI RAJ AND COOPERATION (SHRI S. D. MISRA):

(a) and (b) Yes. The Government of Orissa submitted the following proposals for additional financial assistance for societies organised/to be organised during the third plan period and asked for additional assistance of Rs. 54,000 during the current year. This has been sanctioned. The addi-

tional funds proposed in the subsequent years are tentative and will be discussed during the annual plan discussions. The state government is also working out proposals for additional assistance to societies organised in II Plan period.
