SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA: May I know, Sir, whether any seniority question is still pending or everything is settled?

DR. B. GOPALA REDDI: They have already been settled about two and a half years ago.

INTERNAL RESOURCES FOR THE THIRD FIVE YEAR PLAN

i »589. SHRI ANSARUDDIN AHMAD: will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the public undertakings of the Government of India, will not be able to make

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contribution expected of them to the financial resources of the Third Five Year Plan to the extent originally estimated; and

(b) whether it is a fact that the three steel plants in the public sector are mainly responsible for this shortfall?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT AND FOU PLANNING (SHRI C. R. PATTABHI RAMAN): (a) No reassessment has yet been attempted of the likely contribution of the public undertakings of the Government of India to the resources for the Third Plan. Such a reassessment can be undertaken with advantage only when the balance sheets and profit and loss accounts of these undertakings are available at least for the first year of the Plan, i.e. 1961-62. As these documents are not yet available, it is rather early for such a reassessment.

(b) The question does not arise.

SHRI ANSARUDDIN AHMAD: May I know, Sir, what are the expectations of the Government about raising resources from the contribution made by the public sector undertakings for the first year of the Third Plan, i.e., 1961-62 and how far those expectations have been realised?

SHRI C. R. PATTABHI RAMAN: I may say that it is too early to say anything. We have not got the figures yet.

SHRI NIREN GHOSH: May I know, Sir, whether in respect of the Rour-kela Steel Plant, as a result of defective machinery supplied by the West German collaborators, production has suffered and no profits have been made?

SHRI C. R. PATTABHI RAMAN: I do not know whether that arises out of this question. It relates to returns from Government undertakings and not financial resources of the Third Plan.
