Therefore, whoever may be elected from this House should take special care to see that the Court especially functions and that certain things that are there which are not satisfactory are put right. And I would also request the Member, whoever he may be from this House, to get in touch with the teachers and students of the Visvq-Bharati and find out things for himself so that we can set about in a better way in the functioning of the University.
