(b) whether the Air India International was approached by the Government of Nepal for such a service?

THE PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI JAWAHARLAL NEHRU) : (a) According to our information, there was some talk between representatives of the two Governments for establishing an air service between Dacca and Karachi *via* Kathmandu.

(b) No.

Indian Airlines services operate between India and Nepal and India and Pakistan (both sectors).

PHIZO'S VISIT TO GENEVA

202. SHRI A. D. MANI: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether Phizo, the Naga rebel leader, visited Geneva, and

(b) whether he tried to contact the International Commission of Jurists in order to have his charges against India investigated?

THE PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI JAWAHARLAL NEHRU) : (a) and (b) Mr. Phizo reached Geneva on 9th May 1962 and met the Administrative Secretary of International Commission of Jurists on 10th May 1962. He is reported to have repeated his charges of atrocities by our security forces. The Government of India have received no communication from the International Commission of Jurists. It appears that the Commission has taken no notice of allegations made by Phizo.

U.S. SENATOR SYMINGTON'S VISIT TO INDIA

203. SHRI A. D. MANI: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether Senator Symington of the United States of America recently visited India; and

(b) if so, whether any functions were arranged by his Ministry in his honour?

THE PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI JAWAHARLAL NEHRU) : (a) Senator Symington visited New Delhi from 22nd to 24th October, 1961.

(b) No, Sir. He did not visit India as a State Guest.

SCALES OF PAY OF EMPLOYEES IN GOAN ADMINISTRATION

204. SHRI A. D. MANI: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state whether it is a fact that a gazette notification was issued by the then Military Governor of Goa, Major-General K. P. Candeth, to the effect that fresh employees in the administration will be entitled to scales of pay and allowances applicable to the employees of the Government of India?

THE PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI JAWAHARLAL NEHRU) : Yes, Sir. An Order was issued by the then Military Governor on the 21st April to the effect that fresh recruits will not be entitled to the old Portuguese salaries prevalent in Goa, Daman and Diu and that they will be given Government of India scales of pay.

(क) १९५५-५६ की तुलना में १९६१-६२ में पश्चिमी एशिया और अफ्रीका को हुए हमारे निर्यात में वृद्धि तथा ब्रिटेन, राष्ट्रमण्डल के अन्य देशों, यूरोपीय संघ का बाजार के देशों और दक्षिण-पूर्वी एशिया को हुए निर्यात में कमी हो गई है जैसा कि साथ में संलग्न विवरण से प्रकट होता है। कमी का कारण मुख्यतः किस्म के बारे में दूसरे देशों के साथ होने वाला प्रतिस्पर्धा तथा कुछ देशों द्वारा अपनी अर्थ-व्यवस्था के सम्बन्ध में किये गये मूल्य तथा रोक-टोक विषयक उपाय हैं।
