

(b) if so, what are the reasons therefor and when it is likely to be completed?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH (DR. SUSHILA NAYAR) : (a) and (b) The building is to be constructed in two phases, viz.—

- (1) the Out-patient Department and
- (2) the Wards Block.

The Out-patient Department is under construction and is likely to be completed in about a year's time. Detailed design estimates and constructional designs of the Wards Block are under preparation. The construction is likely to begin by the end of the current year and completed before the end of the Third Five Year Plan.

BENEFITS OF WAR SERVICE TO JUNIOR A.S.MS. OF DELHI DIVISION

98. MIRZA AHMED ALI: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that undue benefits of War Service were given to some Junior Assistant Station Masters of Grade I in Delhi Division of the Northern Railway, during the year 1959;

(b) whether they were asked after a few days of their promotion in Grade II by the Divisional Superintendent, Delhi to give proof of their having been recruited against 70 per cent reserved vacancies; and

(c) if the replies to parts (a) and (b) above are in the affirmative, on what authority they were promoted in higher grade; what action was taken for the irregularity pointed out by the affected staff in their representation and why the staff appointed before 1st June, 1942 have been placed junior to the War Service staff?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN): (a) No.

(b) Yes, six of them.

(c) No irregularity was committed, as the staff concerned were entitled to such promotion. The proof of their having been recruited against 70% reserved vacancies was asked for to confirm that they have been assigned correct seniority. Only such of the railway servants as were appointed to permanent posts before 1-6-42 or were on probation on that date and railway servants appointed up to 31-12-1945 and were selected for confirmation against 30% permanent vacancies that occurred during the period 1-6-42 to 31-12-1945 are senior to war service candidates recruited against 70% war reserved vacancies.
