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If they are going to be in science subjects also, may I know how the difficulty of practicals is going to be solved?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: The present proposal is that they should only be in arts subjects, but the University \% examining the question whether it should take up science subjects also.

श्री भगवत नारायण भार्मव : क्या सरकार को मालूम है कि दिल्ली युनि-वर्मिटी के ग्रतिरिक्त यहां ग्रीर कालेजेज हैं जो पहले से कारेसपांडेंस कोर्स के द्वारा डिग्री देने का ग्रपना विज्ञापन निकालते हैं?

डा० कालू लाल श्रीमाली: श्रगर वे निकालते हैं, तो उसके बरो में मुझे कोई इल्म नहीं है ।

## ZONAL COUNCILS FOR THE PROPAGATION OF HINDI

\*267. SHRI DEOKINANDAN NARA-YAN: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether four Zonal Councils for the propagation of Hindi have been set up in the country; and
- (b) if so, what are the functions of these Councils?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (DR. K. L. SHRIMALI): (a) and (b) A statement is placed on the Table of trie Sabha.

## STATEMENT

- (a) Voluntary Organisations concerned have been requested to take early steps for the setting up of the Regional Councils.
- (b) These Councils are being set up (i) to provide a forum for discussion relating to common problems of

the Voluntary Organisations engaged in Hindi work and (ii) to promote cooperation amongst them.

श्री देवकीनन्दन नारायण : क्या आदरणीय मंत्री महोदय यह बसलाने की कृपा करेंगे कि: यह काम जो आप वालटरी आर्में नाइजेशम की भार्फत आर्में करना चहते हैं, उन वालटरी आर्मेंनाइजेशम की आपमें क्या मदद कियेंगी?

डा० कालू लाल श्रीमाली : हमर्स क्या मदद मिलेगी, यह प्रवत था ?

भी देवकीनंदन नारायण : जी हां ।

डा० कालू लाल श्रीमाली : हम वी मदंद दे रहे हैं ?

श्री देवकीनंदन नारायण : श्रापके स्टेटमेंट में यह लिखा है कि ये जो जोनल कौंकित्म बनेंगी, उन के बनाने का श्रीहतयार वालंटरी: श्रागेंनाइजेशन को होगा, तो ये जोनल कौंकित्म जो हिन्दी के लिये बनाई आयंगी, इस बाम में वालंटरी: श्रागेंनाइजेशंस की श्रापकी नरफ में क्या फाइनेंशियल मदद मिलेगी ?

डा० कालू लाल श्रीमाली : मैंने ग्रापसे निवेदन किया है कि फाइनेशियल मदद तो वालंटरी श्रागेंनाइजेशंस को मिनिस्ट्री श्रव भी दे रही है श्रीर जैसे जैसे काम का विस्तार बढ़ेगा, वैसे वैसे श्रनिरिक्त सहायता ग्रीर दी आयरी ।

श्री देवकीनंदन नारायण : क्या माननीय मंत्री महोदय यह बनलाने की कुपा करेंगे कि बालंटरी ग्रागॅनाइजेशम की ग्रोर के जो ये जीनल कौंसिल्स बलाई आयंगी, उनकी मर्यादा क्या होगी?

डा० कालू लाल श्रीमाली : मारे हिन्दुस्तान में इस बबत ऐसी सार्वेजनिक संस्थाएं हैं जो हिन्दी के प्रचार का काम कर रही हैं। उनका सीमा क्षेत्र अगर निर्धारित हो जाय, तो ठोस कान हो सकता है, श्रीर आपस में उनका सहयोग भी ज्यादा हो सकता है। इसी दृष्टि सं उनका सीमा क्षेत्र निर्धारित किया जा रहा है। अगर यह बात निश्चित हो जाती है, तो उनकी मर्यादा यह होगी कि वे अपनी ही सीमा में इस काम को अच्छी तरह से करें।

SHRI A. D. MANI: I should like 'o "know in how many of the southern States there has been a consistent demand that such Councils should be set up and whether the demand has had the backing of the State Governments.

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: We had called a conference of these organisations in 1960. The conference was held in 1960 and one of the suggestions which were made at this conference of voluntary organisations was that a forum might be created for the formulation of a co-ordinated plan of action for the future, and they recommended that Zonal Councils might be set up. Then we set up a Committee consisting of Shri Maganbhai Desai, Shri M. L. Dwiwedy, Shri Mohanlal Bhatt, Shri G. P. Nene and Shri K. D. Bhargava, and they recommended that an all-India voluntary organisation should be set up. This matter was considered by the Hindi Siksha Samity which represents all the State Governments including the southern States to which the hon. Member is referring. They also accepted this in principle. Therefore, we appointed another Committee to examine this question further and it is now proposed that four Regional Councils should be set up, and we have appointed some conveners for the respective regions. They are: Shri Maganbhai Desai for the western region; Shri S. R. Sastry for the southern region; Shri Rajani Kanta Chakravarty for the eastern region; and Shri S. N. Parimoo for the northern region. Thev are all from

the respective regions, and they are contacting the respective organisations, and as soon as this matter is finalised the Regional Councils will be set up.

SHRI R. S. KHANDEKAR: May I know which are the non-official agencies receiving Government aid in this connection?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: The Dakshin Hindi Prachar Sabha, the Hindi Sahitya Sommelan, the Nagari Pra-charini Sabha, practically most of the voluntary organisations are receiving aid from the Government for the propagation of Hindi.

SHRI B. K. P. SINHA: While in one or two States there may be opposition to what they call imposition of Hindi, there is no opposition to the propagation of Hindi in any State. Is this a fact?

DR. K. L. SHR\*\*1ALI: As far as I am aware, there is full co-operation from all the States. As far as the propagation of Hindi is concerned., we have not experienced any difficulty. In fact, various other schemes have been taken up in collaboration with the State Governments, and progress is being made satisfactorily.

SHRI N. M. LINGAM: Ma<sub>v</sub> I know if the formation of the Councils is in pursuance of the Presidential Order under clause (2) of article 343 of the Constitution Or independently of it? If it is independently of it, what was the need for setting up such Councils when the Presidential Order covers all aspects of thedevelopment of Hindi?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: Actually the President in his directive dated the 27th April 1960 had desired that a re view of the existing arrangements for the propagation of Hindi to devise ways and means for effective work in the future should be undertaken. This review was undertaken as a result of that. As I have stated, a conference of voluntary, organisations was called, and it was this conference which had recommended the setting up of these Councils.

श्री विमलकुमार मन्नालालजी चोरिड्या : क्या मंत्री तहोदय बतायेंगे कि हिन्दी के क्षेत्रों में जो बालंटरी आर्गेनाइजेशंस हैं, उनको हिन्दी के प्रचार के लिए सहायता देने का लक्ष्य क्या है ?

डा० कालू लाल श्रीमाली: हिन्दी का प्रकार ग्रीर हिन्दों का विकास दो बातें हैं। हिन्दी का प्रवार तो जो नान-हिन्दी स्वार्किंग स्टेड्स हैं उनमें होता है। हिन्दों का विकास करने की भी उनको जिम्मेदारी है ग्रीर उनको सहायता इसी लेए दो जाता है।

SHRI DEOKINANDAN NARAYAN": May I know if it is the intention of the Government to bring about unity among the different organisations that are working for Hindi in different States?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: Certainly this will bring about great co-ordination between the different organisations.

## SCARCITY OF CEMENT

\*268. SHRI DEOKINANDAN NA-RAYAN: Will the Minister of STEEL AND HEAVY INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) the reasons for the scarcity of cement in the country; and
- (b) whether cement is distributed to every State in proportion to its demand?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL AND HEAVY INDUSTRIES (SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM): (a) The present demand for cement in the country is in excess of its availability.

(b) No, Sir.

SHRI DEOKINANDAN NARAYAN: May I know if the Government has decided to entrust this work of distribution to the State Governments or to the co-operative societies?

SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM: The State Governments, and the State Governments may decide to distribute it through co-operatives.

SHRI DEOKINANDAN NARAYAN: May I know if any preferences are decided upon for distribution?

SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM: It is the function of the State Governments; they have to decide the preference.

SHRI DEOKINANDAN NARAYAN: May I know if it is a fact that a large quantity of cement which they give for Government buildings and projects is sold in the black market by government contractors? Is it not a foot?

SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM: If the hon. Member has any definite information, he may pass that on to me.

SHRI PANNALAL SARAOGI: May I know whether it is a fact that whatever quota is allotted to the different regions does not reach them for lack of transport facilities? This is a grave situation and adds fuel to the Are. On the other hand, the cement factories are continuously complaining of over-congestion. Could something be done in that direction?

SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM: Well, Sir, there has been some difficulty with regard to transport facilities also, and we are trying to move cement by road also as far as possible.

SHRI N. SRI RAMA REDDY: Ihe hon. Minister was pleased to state that the demand in the country was far in excess of the production. I would like to know if any attempts are being made to increase the production.

SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM: Yes, Sir. Every attempt is being made to increase the production within the existing capacity and also to build up extra production capacity.

SHRI ARJUN ARORA: May I know how the quotas for the differ-
