(ग) जो नहीं । अधिकारियों को स्टाक की स्थिति का पता था, किन्तु स्टॉक को फिर से पूर्ति करने में कुछ देरी हो गई ।

(व) उपयुक्त फार्म प्राप्त करने में जिन कर्तवारियों के कारण देरो हुई, उनके विरुद्ध उचित कार्रवाई को जा रही है। कताट प्लेस स्थित डाक वर में कफ़ो संख्या में फार्म सेज दिये गये हैं, जिससे कि फार्मों की कसो को भविष्य में पूनरावृत्ति न हो।

f[THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM) : (a) No, Sir. Only Connaught Place Post Office did not accept payments for telephone bills for some time on the 24th April, 1962 for want of receipt books.

(b) This was due mainly to exceptionally heavy issue of receipts on the previous day which was about double the average number issued normally, and also the unsatisfactory stock position of the Eng-9 form owing to the failure of the Government Presses to supply adequate quantities.

(c) No. The officers were aware of the stock position but there was some delay in replenishing the stock.

(d) Suitable action is being taken against the officials at fault for delay in obtaining the appropriate form. Adequate quantities have been supplied to Connaught Place Post Office to prevent a recurrence of the shortage.]

\*390. SHRIMATI NANDINI SAT-PATH Y: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have received any petitions from public for opening a passenger halt between Hindol Road and Meramandeli Railway-Stations on the South Eastern Railway in the State of Orissa; and

(b) if so, what steps Government have taken in this connection?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The proposal was examined but not accepted for want of adequate justification at present.

## PHOTOGRAPHS OF SCHOOL-GOING CHILDREN FOR AVAILING OF RAILWAY TICKET CONCESSION

\*391. SHRI V. V. SARWATE: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the photographs of the school-going children who apply for railway ticket concession for going to their native places during summer vacation are also required to be sent with the applications;

(b) if so, what are the reas'ons for the same; and

(c) whether students holding photoidentity cards, duly signed by the head of the educational institution concerned, can be allowed such concessions on the production of such identity card without the production 'of copies of photographs?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI S. V. Ramaswamy): (a) No, Sir.

(b) and (c) Do not arise.
