

ISSUE OF NEW STAMPS

98. SHRI BIREN ROY: Will the Minister of TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) what are the reasons for stopping the issue of new special stamps in the two denominations of 15 nP. and 90 nP.; and

(b) how many new stamps individually or in series are proposed to be issued in 1962?

THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS (DR. P. SUBBARAYAN): (a) Special issues are brought out in more than one denomination whenever it is considered necessary and feasible;

(b) Sixteen new stamps will be issued in 1962 including one in a series depicting "Wild Life".

FLYING AND GLIDING CLUBS

(c) the number of aircraft (with types) allowed to be purchased by the respective Flying and Gliding Clubs in India and from abroad and their value; and

(d) the amount of ex-gratia payments not covered by subsidy agreements made to any Flying or Gliding Clubs since 1959?
