ISSUE OF NEW STAMPS

- 98. SHRI BIREN ROY: Will the Minister of Transport and Communications be pleased to state:
- (a) what are the reasons for stopping the issue of new special stamps in the two denominations of 15 nP. and 90 nP.; and
- (b) how many new stamps individually or in series are proposed to be issued in 1962?

THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS (Dr. P. SUBBARAYAN): (a) Special issues are brought out in more than one denomination whenever it is considered necessary and feasible;

(b) Sixteen new stamps will be issued in 1962 including one in a series depicting "Wild Life".
