

**SHRI N. KANUNGO:** I am afraid that is not correct because, in some places where the demand is there, I mean where people are alert, there is always a scramble and there is kept a waiting list, and in some other places, for various reasons, the people are not interested and therefore the Estates are not fully occupied.

**SHRI DEOKINANDAN NARAYAN:** May I know, Sir, if these Industrial Estates are organised on a co-operative basis or separately on individual basis?

**SHRI N. KANUNGO:** No, Sir, the Estate is located where the facilities are available. Co-operative societies can take it or individuals can take it.

**SHRI S. C. DEB:** May I know, Sir, whether the 81 Industrial Estates approved in 1961-62 were in excess of the 119 already sanctioned?

**SHRI N. KANUNGO:** Yes, Sir. Not only that, further ones have been sanctioned, but then it takes a little time; it is year to year. Even in the five-year period there is a spillover, because there are always difficulties about acquiring the land, putting up the buildings, and particularly in getting facilities like electricity and water supply.

## SHORT NOTICE QUESTION AND ANSWER

### LABOUR RIOTS AT KOTHAGUDIAM

2. SHRI RATANLAL KISHORILAL MALVIYA: Will the Minister of LABOUR and EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the causes of labour riots which occurred on or about the 23rd March, 1962 at Kothagudiam;

(b) the number of labourers killed and injured in the riots;

(c) the loss of property sustained by the employers and the public; and

(d) the steps taken by Government to restore peace in the industry and the affected areas?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF LABOUR (SHRI ABID ALI): (a) On 21st March, 1962 a quarrel took place near a toddy shop between two groups of mine workers, who were presumably drunk.

(b) Five persons were killed and 38 injured.

(c) Information is not available.

(d) 28 persons have been arrested for rioting etc. A magisterial enquiry into the firing by police has been ordered by the State Government. A peace committee has also been formed and the situation is now quiet.

SHRI RATANLAL KISHORILAL MALVIYA: Will the hon. Minister give the details of the dispute at the today shop, which caused such a big riot and state whether the riot was general or between groups of labour and, if the latter, which were the two groups of labour?

SHRI ABID ALI: As I have submitted in reply to part (a) of the question, it took place near a toddy shop and the persons were presumably drunk.

SHRI RATANLAL KISHORILAL MALVIYA: I wanted to know which were the two groups of labour that took part in this riot.

12 Noon.

SHRI ABID ALI: Yes, Sir. Unfortunately one belonged to the camp called Gorakhpuri and another, local.

SHRI RATANLAL KISHORILAL MALVIYA: May I know, Sir, if it is a fact that the dispute between these two groups of labourers, Gorakhpuri and local, was over some woman with whom one of them misbehaved?

SHRI ABID ALI: Yes, Sir. The report says that a worker made some signs towards a woman passing through that area.

SHRI K. L. NARASIMHAM: May I know, Sir, whether this happened in the toddy shop?

SHRI ABID ALI: Near the toddy shop.

SHRI K. L. NARASIMHAM: Is the Minister aware where the toddy shop is in Kothagudiam?

SHRI ABID ALI: In the town itself.
