CO-OPERATIVE SUGAR MILLS

***190. SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA:** Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) the number of sugar mills working at present on co-operative basis;

(b) whether any new licences have been granted in 1960 for the establishment of sugar mills by co-operative societies; and

(c) whether there are any pending applications from co-operative societies for grant of licences for sugar mills?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURE (SHRI A. M. THOMAS): (a) 29.

(b) In 1960, 13 applications have been approved for grant of licences.

(c) 37 applications are pending.

STALLS IN THE VICINITY OF BHADRAK RAILWAY STATION

***191. SHRI BIBUDHENDRA MISRA:** Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of persons permitted to put stalls in the vicinity of the Bhadrak Railway Station in the South-Eastern Railway;

(b) the total monthly collection of rent from these stalls; and

(c) whether it is a fact that the stall-owners have been asked by the Divisional Engineer, South-Eastern Railway to vacate the land allotted to them; and if so, why?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI S. V. RAMASWAMY): (a) 20.

(b) Rs. 190 per month.

(c) Yes. The licencees have sublet the stalls to unauthorised persons and the rent has fallen into heavy arrears. Also the present stall holders are not keeping the site neat and tidy, as required under the agreement.

ENQUIRY CLERKS ON THE SOUTH-EASTERN RAILWAY

***192. SHRI BIBUDHENDRA MISRA:** Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether enquiry clerks (Grade III) serving in the South-Eastern Railway are required to pass any departmental test for confirmation in service;

(b) if so, what are the rules prescribed for the departmental test; and

(c) whether persons appointed prior to the formulation of these rules also are required to appear in such a test?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI S. V. RAMASWAMY): (a) to (c) Information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the Sabha.

RAILWAY ACCIDENT AT OBEIDULLAGANJ NEAR BHOPAL

***193. SHRI A. D. MANI:** Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether on the 8th March, 1959, a person named Shri Kalka Prasad, his wife, Shrimati Lumabai, and his sons, Mahesh Kumar and Munnoo, were killed in a Railway accident at the Obeidullaganj railway station near Bhopal;

(b) whether the accident was caused by a goods train 741 coming from Hoshangabad without its headlight and without giving any whistle;

(c) whether on the day on which the accident took place the platform was not properly lighted; and

(d) whether the sons of the deceased Shri Kalka Prasad had made representations to Government for compensation and if so, what action Government have taken thereon?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI S. V. RAMASWAMY): (a) Yes Sir.

(b) Driver of goods train sounded engine whistle while entering the station. Head light was defective but buffer lamps were functioning.

(c) No Sir.

(d) Yes Sir, a claim for Rs. 25,000 was received but this on examination was found inadmissible.
