

(a) whether a new building project to be known as the "Indian Pentagon" has been decided upon and included in the Third Five Year Plan to house the Ministry of Defence and the Army and the Navy Headquarters;

(b) if so, what are the main features of the project and where the building is to be located; and

(c) what is the estimated cost thereof?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI V. K. KRISHNA MENON): (a) to (c). Office buildings to accommodate certain Branches of the Army and Naval Headquarters and the Inter-Service Organisations is proposed to be constructed behind the South Block on plots Nos. 35 and 36, on which there are hutments at present. Plans and estimates have not yet been prepared. No proposal about naming any building as "Indian Pentagon" is before Government.

BARAUNI OIL REFINERY

180. SHRIMATI SAVITRY DEVI NIGAM: Will the Minister of STEEL, MINES AND FUEL be pleased to state by when the foreign experts and personnel on the Barauni Oil Refinery are likely to be replaced by Indian experts and personnel?

THE MINISTER OF MINES AND OIL (SHRI K. D. MALAVTYA) : The services of the foreign experts and personnel, are being obtained, in terms of the Indo-Soviet Agreement dated 28th September, 1959 to avail of their technical assistance in the construction, erection and operation of the refinery. Their numbers and periods of stay will vary from time to time consistent with the nature of work. The services of the last batch of these experts may not be required after about one year of the commencement of full scale operations.
