#### MANUFACTURE OF TURBINES

**\*502. SHRI BABUBHAI CHINAI:** Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Russia has withdrawn its original offer to help India in the manufacture of turbines; and

(b) if so, what are the reasons for the same?

**THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI MANUBHAI SHAH):** (a) and (b) No, Sir. Negotiations are still continuing.

**SHRI BABUBHAI CHINAI:** May I know whether, besides Russia, the Government is thinking of having any collaboration or 'know-how' arrangement with any other country?

**SHRI MANUBHAI SHAH:** As is well known and as I have placed before the House already, we are also establishing a project in collaboration with Czechoslovakia for the manufacture of electrical equipment.

**\*503. SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA:** Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND A.I.R. STATION AT AGRA

BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have taken any decision for the establishment of an All India Radio broadcasting station at Agra;

(b) if the reply to part (a) above be in the affirmative, whether any

site has been selected for the purpose; and

(c) by when the station is likely to start functioning?

**THE MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI B. V. KESKAR):** (a) It has been decided to install a high power medium wave relay transmitter at or near Agra, but no full-fledged broadcasting station is being established there.

(b) Selection of site is in progress.

(c) It is too early to say with any precision when the transmitter will start functioning.

**SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA:** May I know whether the decision was taken as a result of representations received from Agra?

**DR. B. V. KESKAR:** No, Sir. The decision to put up the transmitter at Agra or near Agra was taken on technical considerations. Originally this transmitter was to be put up at Delhi itself.

**DR. RAGHUBIR SINH:** May I know which programmes it is going to transmit and from which stations they are being now transmitted?

**DR. B. V. KESKAR:** This is meant entirely for the relay of the All India Radio Light Programme known as Vividh Bharathi.

#### MISUSE OF NEWSPRINT QUOTA

**\*504. SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA:** Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to refer to the answer given to Unstarred Question No. 27 in the Rajya Sabha on the 20th April, 1961 and state:
