They were Meos. Some of them had gone away to Pakistan and got back to U.P. A large number of applications running into thousands have been considered under section 16.

SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA: May I know, Sir, if the hon. Minister has any information whether Pakistan has any evacuee property at present?

SHRI MEHR CHAND KHANNA: As far as India is concerned, we abrogated unilaterally the Evacuee Property Law in 1954 and from April, 1957, excepting in those cases which were already pending, nobody else or no other property in the country can be declared evacuee. But, I am sorry to say, Sir, that as far as Pakistan is concerned, the Evacuee Property Law is still in its application.

(a) whether the machines required for the expansion of the factory of the Hindustan Machine Tools Ltd., have now been received; and

(b) the names of the countries, where orders for supply of those machines were placed?]

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI MANUBHAI SHAH): (a) and (b) A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT

All the machines required for the expansion of the H.M.T. factory have been received except a few items of balancing equipment which will be imported as soon as necessary foreign exchange is made available. The construction of the Civil Engineering portion has been completed in May 1961, 10 months ahead of schedule. Production has commenced in June 1961. The machines have been imported from West Germany, Italy, U.K., Switzerland, Czechoslovakia and East Germany.

SHRI MAHESWAR NAIK: May I know, Sir, whether our attempts at manufacture of machines for the production of machine tools have not succeeded so far?

SHRI MANUBHAI SHAH: They have, but the world is advancing so fast and so speedily in these matters of technology that one can never be hundred per cent. self-sufficient in these machineries.

†PLOTS FOR JHUGGI-DWELLERS

*429. **PROF. DR. RAGHU VIR:** Will the Minister of WORKS, HOUSING AND SUPPLY be pleased to state the

size of plots and streets that are being newly-planned for Jhuggi-dwellers in Delhi?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF WORKS, HOUSING AND SUPPLY: (SHRI ANIL K. CHAND): The size of the plots under the Jhuggi's and Jhopri's Clearance Scheme is to be about 80 square yards each. The size of the streets would vary according to the integrated development planned for the different areas. Normally, the Corporation propose to provide 24 feet wide streets in front of the plots and 10 feet wide service lanes. The main approach roads to these colonies would be 60 feet wide.

PROF. DR. RAGHU VIR: Sir, as the dwellers of jhopris are mostly poor men unable to spend enough money to construct kacha jhopri with thatched roofs, what steps are the Government taking to see that what is built anew does not form new slums, and what steps are the Government taking to provide finances for constructing some of the standard homes, and secondly, how many families are being helped by them during the current year, and lastly, how many years it will take them to rehabilitate all these jhuggi and jhopri dwellers?

SHRI ANIL K. CHANDA: It is an omnibus question. So many questions have been twisted together and I do not know whether I stand but I can give a rough idea. Under the Jhuggi and Jhopri Scheme which was accepted by the Government some time last year, it is proposed to develop about 800 acres of land round about Delhi by the Municipal Corporation of Delhi, and plots measuring 80 sq. yards each are to be given to enumerated squatter population. Each plot will cost about Rs. 1750. It will be a developed area and there will be a raised platform, a water pipe, a sanitary latrine etc. and of the cost of Rs. 1,750, Rs. 875
