

of over 3,30,000 tons of Ammonium Sulphate during the period 1956-57 to 1958-59. During 1959-60 and 1960-61, however, the production declined. The Fertilizer Corporation of India have appointed an expert committee to go into the problem of fall in production at the Sindri Fertilizer Factory. Two Dutch Experts who have extensive experience in coal and coke gasification processes have been associated with its deliberations. The Committee has completed its investigations and the report is expected to be submitted shortly, to the Board of Directors.

(d) A preliminary enquiry held to determine the causes of deterioration in the plant revealed that the reasons for the deterioration are the following:

- (i) wear and tear of the machinery;
- (ii) deterioration in the quality of coal;
- (iii) deterioration in the quality of gypsum.

#### VIOLATION OF CEASE-FIRE LINE IN KASHMIR BY PAKISTANI ARMYMEN IN DISGUISE

\*43. SHRI M. S. GURUPADA SWAMY: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Pakistani army-men have resorted to the use of automatic weapons and are violating the cease-fire line in Kashmir in plain clothes instead of their uniforms;

(b) if so, whether Government have drawn the attention of the United Nations Observers to such violation of the cease-fire line by Pakistani army-men; and

(c) what action Government have taken to stop these violations by the Pakistani army-men?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRIMATI LAKSHMI MENON): (a) Yes, Sir. There have been so many violations of the

cease-fire line in many of which plain clothes personnel have been using automatic weapons, Light Machine Guns, etc. against us.

(b) Yes, Sir.

(c) We have firmly protested to the C.M.O. We have taken no unilateral action. But in many places we have been compelled to return the fire or take hostile action against the armed PAK/POK intruders who are in reality and law part of the Pakistan Army.
