\*148. SHRI GURUDEV: Will the Minister of Steel, Mines and Fuel be pleased to state how many coal mines in the country are controlled by English firms and how many of these are in Madhya Pradesh?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL, MINES AND FUEL (SARDAR SWARAN SINGH): Of the companies controlling collieries in India there are only two which are incorporated in England. They control 10 collieries between themselves. None of these are located in Madhya Pradesh.
