**REFERENCE TO THE MURDER
OF MR. LUMUMBA AND HIS
COLLEAGUES**

SHRI GUPTA (West Bengal): Sir,
may I make this en-

quiry from the Government through you?
News has come of the ghastly murder of
Mr. Lumumba and his colleagues. May I
know whether the Government have got
any information in regard to this crime
against mankind? I think something
should be stated before we adjourn, if the
Government are in possession of such in-
formation. We would also like to know
what steps the Government is going to
take in regard to this matter.
