SHRI ARJUN ARORA: May I know which are the States which did not favour it and which favoured it?

SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR: The Andhra Pradesh Government did not support. The Government of Mysore supported. The Government of Kerala does not support. The Government of Assam, "no". The Government of Bihar, "no, it is premature". The Government of Bombay, "not feasible". The Government of Madras, "not in favour". The Government of Madhya Pradesh have not agreed. The Government of Orissa is agreeable for a pool. The Government of Rajasthan, "do not propose". The Government of Punjab, "do not consider it worth while". West Bengal, "not possible". Uttar Pradesh, "not in favour".

SHRIMATI T. NALLAMUTHU RAMAMURTI: What is the matter with the mental health in this country?

SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR: It is sound.

SHRI B. K. P. SINHA: May I know the idea was to have a Mental Health Service as distinct from an All India Health Service? Why was it proposed to have a distinct Mental Health Service?

SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR: That is the question, Sir.

MR. CHAIRMAN: He is asking you, instead of having an All India Health

Service, why did you make this suggestion for an All India Mental Health Service.

SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR: That was really the question why the State Governments differed from that. They consider that it is not worth while.

#### TRAIN BETWEEN MANMAD AND KACHEGUDA AND PURLI-VAIJNATH AND BASIM

\*397. SHRI BABA SAHEB SAVNEKAR: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that usually all trains running between Manmad and Kacheguda (Hyderabad) and Purli-Vaijnath and Basim run late; and

(b) if so, what steps Government propose to take to maintain punctuality of train runnings on these lines?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN): (a) No Sir, except on the Purna-Basim Section.

(b) The Purna-Basim section is a newly opened section. The train services comprise of one passenger and one mixed train each way. The mixed trains have to perform shunting operations at intermediate stations which affects their punctuality. In the time table to come into force from 1-4-61 it is proposed to discontinue running of mixed trains, which step is expected to ensure a satisfactory standard of punctuality.
