PURCHASE OF BUSES BY DELHI TRANSPORT UNDERTAKING

- ♦223. SHRI BABUBHAI CHINAI: (ON BEHALF OF SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA): Will the Minister of TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to stale:
- (a) whether any amount was given in 1960-61 by Government to the Delhi Transport Undertaking for purchase of buses;
- (b) whether any amount is proposed to be given in 1961-62 for the same purpose; and
- (c) if the answer to part (a) ca: (b) above be in the affirmative, how many buses are to be purchased with that amount?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN IHB MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI RAJ BAHADUR): (a) Yes; a loan of Rs. 40 lakhs was given to the Dslhi Transport Undertaking during 1960-61 for purchase of buses and for meeting other capital expenditure;

- (b) A provision for a loan of Rs. 46 lakhs has been made in the Budget for 1961-62;
- (c) The Undertaking purchased 50 buses during 1960-61 from the loan advanced to them and 10 buses from their own resources. They propose to purchase a total of 104 buses during 1961-62 from the loan money and their own resources.
