

ESTABLISHMENT OF VILLAGE EXTENSION CENTRES

159. SHRI B. N. BHARGAVA: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state the number of Village Extension Centres established under the Key Village Scheme in each State during the Second Five Year Plan as against the target fixed?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI M. V. KRISHNAPPA): A target for the establishment of 72 Key Village Extension Centres was fixed under the Second Five Year Plan on the basis of Working Group discussions and the funds allocated by them to the States. As against this, 67 Centres have been established so far as per state-wise details in the appended statement.
