Admission of Delhi students into colleges

*751. SHRI DEOKINANDAN NARA-YAN: Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

- (a) how many students in De hi could not get admission into colleges this year; and
- (b) whether students were refused admission on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in lower examinations?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (Dr. K. L. SHRIMALI): (a) 7,054 students could not get admission in Prep. (Arts and Science) and year of Pre-Medical, B.A. (Pass Hons.) B.Sc. (Pass & Hons.) and B. Com. courses this year. In addition, about 1,939 in-service students failed to secure admission in the evening colleges. A number of these students had applied for admission to more than one college. It is, therefore, not possible to indicate the actual number of students who were not able to get admission.

(b) Colleges do not entertain applications from students who do not possess the minimum percentage of marks fixed by the University for admission to different courses of study. Students are also refused admission when the number of seats allocated for each class in the college are filled up.

On the basis of preliminary work carried out, none of the deposits recorded are considered to be of such a nature as could be considered of any economic significance. In order of priorities, keeping in view the significance of deposits recorded elsewhere in the country, these deposits do not warrant any further work at this stage.]
