INDIAN SCHOOL OF MINES AND APPLIED GEOLOGY, DHANBAD

64. SHRI B. N. BHARGAVA: Will the Minister of SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether there are centres in each State for holding entrance examination of the Indian School of Mines and Applied Geology, Dhanbad;

(b) if so, what are the names of those centres; and

(c) if the answer to part (a) above be in the negative, whether Government propose to open such centres; and if so, when?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS (DR. MONO MOHAN DAS):

(a) No, Sir.

(b) and (c). The centres approved for the Entrance Examination are:

Dhanbad, Calcutta, Bombay, Madras, Delhi, Nagpur, Patna, Lucknow, and Cuttack.

The examination may not necessarily be held at all of these centres in any particular year.

The question of opening centres in other States is under consideration.

JOINT EXPEDITION TO BHUTAN AND SIKKIM

66. SHRI B. N. BHARGAVA: Will the Minister of SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state whether Government have accepted the request made by the Birbal Sahni Institute of Palaeobotany for financial assistance for undertaking a joint expedition with a Japanese botanist to Bhutan and Sikkim?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS (DR. MONO MOHAN DAS): Financial assistance of Rs. 2,000/- was given to the Birbal Sahni Institute of Palaeobotany for a joint expedition with Japanese Botanists to Darjeeling and some areas in Sikkim. The Institute has not asked for any financial assistance for any joint expedition with Japanese Botanists to Bhutan recently.

INDIAN TEAMS FOR ROME OLYMPICS

67. SHRI JUGAL KISHORE: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state the number of Indian teams and players who will participate in the Olympics to be held at Rome?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (DR. K. L. SHRIMALI): The final composition of the Indian Contingent to the Olympic Games has not yet been finalised. The Government of India have, however, agreed to render financial assistance and foreign exchange facilities in respect of the following teams and players:—

(a) An Atheletic team of 11 male athletes;

(b) A Hockey team consisting of 20 players;

(c) A Football team consisting of 18 players;

(d) A Wrestling team consisting of 5 Wrestlers; and

(e) A Rifle Shooting team consisting of 3 Shooters.
