COLLAPSE OF TWENTY CONCRETE POSTS ON THE EASTERN RAILWAY

Due to sudden release of tension in the Overhead wires, 20 pre-stressed concrete poles, 10 on either side of the.

cut length suddenly collapsed and blocked the Railway line.

SHRi ANSARUDDIN AHMAD: May I know whether the attention of the hon. Minister has been drawn to a statement in the press in Calcutta that these posts collapsed not because the wires were cut but because they were defective in construction?

SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN: That aspect is also being looked into by the General Manager and the Chief Engineer.
