camps in West Bengal. Only a small percentage of artisans such as carpenters, masons and blacksmiths, are to be moved from amongst non-campers to fill up local shortages of skilled workers and with a view to building integrated rural communities of displaced persons. As regards the latter, the Dandakaranya Development Authority will continue to work under the directions of the Ministry of Rehabilitation and the question as to which Ministry of the Government of India should deal with it when the Ministry of Rehabilitation is wound up, will be considered at the appropriate time

It has also been decided that if at any lime the Chief Minister of West Bengal is invited to attend the meeting of the Rehabilitation Committee of the Cabinet where matters concerning Dandakaranya are discussed, invitation will also be extended to the Chief Ministers of Orissa and Madhya Pradesh.

GRATUITY, PENSION AND LIFE INSURANCE SCHEMES FOR LABOUR IN MTNINF! AND COAL INDUSTRIES

*407. SHRI RATANLAL KISHORI-LAL MALVIYA: Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any schemes for the grant of gratuity, pension and life insurance for the labour in mining and coal industry are under Government's consideration; and
- (b) if so, what are the details of the schemes?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF LABOUR (SHRI ABID ALI): (a) A general scheme of pension/gratuity for all organised industries including mining and coal industries as recommended by the Study Group on Social Security is under consideration. The i workers are at liberty to pay for life insurance premium from their own provident fund accumulations and from wages through employers also.

Payment of Wages Act has been appropriately amended recently.

(b) Details of the scheme of pension /gratuity may be seen in the Study Group's report which has already been laid on the Table of the House.

DISPLACED PERSONS FROM EAST PAKISTAN AT MALA

- *412. SHRI J. C. CHATTERJI: Will the Minister of REHABILITATION AND MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the news item published in the National Herald, supplied by its Pilibhit correspondent, on the 25th June, 1960, in which a Member of the Legislative Assembly has complained of the miserable plight of the displaced persons from East Pakistan settled last year at Mala in Pilibhit District;
- (b) whether it is a fact that land promised to the displaced persons has not been given to them;
- (c) whether it is a fact that there is no dispensary, school or lighting arrangement at Mala and that the hut ments of displaced persons are losing plaster and their roofs are leaking; and
- (d) if so, what steps are being taken by Government to provide essential facilities to the displaced persons there?

THE MINISTER OF REHABILITATION AND MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRI MEHR CHAND KHANNA): (a) to (d) The information has been called for from the State Government and willbe placed on the Table of the Sabha when received.

- (c) whether the Dalai Lama has given any assistance to any official or nonofficial agency for this purpose and if so, what?]

बैदेशिक-कार्य उपमंत्री (श्रीमती लक्ष्मी एन० मेनन): (क)सारे तिब्बती शरणार्थियों की पूर्व स्थित (एंटिसिडेंट्स) की जांच-पड़ताल करना सरकार के लिये संभव नहीं है। फिर भी हमारी पुलिस उनके भारत में प्रवेश करते समय उनकी छानबीन करती है।

(ख) १६५६-६० के दौरान में सरकार ने तिब्बती शरणाधियों की सहायता ब्रौर पुनर्वास पर ४१,५६,६१४ रुपये खर्च किये हैं। प्राइवेट एजेंसियों ने इस सम्बन्ध में जो खर्च किया है उसका पता नहीं है। (ग) मालूम हुआ है कि दलाई लामा ने तिब्बती शरणार्थियों में ५०,००० रुपये बांटे हैं । उन्होंने एक तिब्बती स्कूल की स्थापना के लिये ५०,००० रु० की और रकम देने का बचन दिया है । संभव है कि उन्होंने शरणार्थियों को अन्य रूपों में भी सहायता दी हो ।

- (b) Rs. 41,59,614, have been spent by the Government during 1959-60 on re'ief and rehabilitation of Tibetan refugees. Exoenditure incurred by private agencies on this accoun^u is not known.
- (c) The Dalai Lama is known to have distributed Rs. 50,000 among the Tibetan refugees. He has offered another Rs 50.000 towards the establishment of a Tibetan school. It is likely that he has also provided assistance to the refugees in other ways.]
