## DIRECT TELEPHONE LINE BETWEEN BHIWANI AND PILANI

\*450. SHRI BANSI LAL: Will the Minister of TRANSPORT AND COMMU-NICATIONS be pleased to state whether Government propose to install a direct telephone line between Bhiwani and Pilani and if so, when?

THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS (DR. P. SUBBARAYAN): No, Sir. There is at present no justification for such a proposal.

## SENIORITY LIST OF BRAKESMEN OF THE SOUTHERN RAILWAY

\*451. SHRI M. S. GURUPADA SWAMY: Will the Minister of RAIL-WAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a combined seniority list of all officiating and temporary brakesmen of the Southern Railway has been prepared; and

(b) if so, whether it has adversely affected the services of thirty brakesmen?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF RAIL-WAYS (SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) No, Sir.

SHRI M. S. GURUPADA SWAMY: May I know, Sir, what factors were taken into consideration in compiling this combined seniority list, and whether it is a fact that this has adversely affected the interest of certain Mysore employees?

SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN: Sir, the position is that on the metregauge section of the Southern Railway there are some very steep gradients and we had to employ certain brakesmen to help the driver to control the train for applying handbrakes physically. Now, we have replaced those handbrakes by automotic vacuum brakes with the result that a certain number of brakesmen have become surplus We have compiled a combined seniority list so that the junior most men, and not the people who are higher up, are reverted.

to Questions

SHRI M. S. GURUPADA SWAMY: May I know, Sir, whether it is not a fact that there had been direct recruitment to these posts of brakesmen some time back? Could the hon. Minister give an assurance that hereafter posts will be filled up out of these surplus men?

SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN: After the Government install automatic vacuum brakes, these people will become surplus to our requirements. Therefore, the alternative before us will be either to offer them another job or to terminate their services because their services are no longer required. We thought that it would be better not to throw them out of employment but offer them alternative jobs.

SHRI M. S. GURUPADA SWAMY: May I know, Sir, whether this thing was not anticipated at the time of the recruitment of those people to these places?

SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN: No, Sir. It could not be anticipated because automatic vacuum brakes have been introduced on this particular metre-gauge section only recently.

LACK OF A GOODS SHED AT JAWALA-MUKHI ROAD
