EXPENDITURE INCURRED ON THE MEDICAL TREATMENT OF HEADS OF INDIAN MISSIONS ABROAD

290. SHRI FARIDUL HAQ ANSARI: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) the total amount spent in each of the years 1956-57, 1957-58, 1958-59 and 1959-60 on the medical treatment of Indian Ambassadors, High Commissioners and other Heads of the Indian Missions abroad; and

(b) whether the total expenditure on this account exceeded Rs. 10,000 on any individual case and if so, under what circumstances?

THE PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI JAWAHARLAL NEHRU): (a) and (b) As expenditure on medical assistance in respect of officers abroad is not shown separately, in the accounts received at Headquarters, it has not been found possible to collect the required information from the records available in Delhi. The necessary information is, however, being obtained from our Missions abroad and will be laid on the Table of the House.

MANUFACTURE OF TRANSISTOR RADIO SETS

291. SHRI DAHYABHAI V. PATEL: Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to refer to the answer given to Starred Question No. 154 in the Rajya Sabha on the 11th August, 1960 and state:

(a) whether the manufacture of transistor radio sets in India will be with foreign collaboration and/or capital and if so, who are the collaborators; and

(b) what* will be the capital from outside India in each case?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI MANUBHAI SHAH): (a) The manufacture of transistorised radio sets is being undertaken by existing radio manufacturers. Some of them are already working in technical/
