REPORT OF THE PARLIAMENTARY DELEGATION TO ASSAM

MR. CHAIRMAN: This morning the Report of the Delegation of Members of Parliament who visited Assam was sent *to* me. Mr. Santhanam will now place it before the House.

STATEMENT *RE* CHOLERA/GAS-TRO-ENTERITIS IN DELHI, TTAR PRADESH AND PUNJAB

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH (SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR): Sir, in the Union Territory of Delhi so far from the 1st January to the 26th August, 1960, altogether 1224 cases of gastro-enteritia with 59 deaths have been reported For the corresponding periods of 195f and 1959 there were 480 cases with 32
