THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (DR. SHAKEEL AHMAD): (a) There are 311 requests pending with the Department, for opening of new post offices in various Postal Circles. So far, during the current financial year, 57 post offices have been opened in the country by relocation. Circlewise details are as under:
