

and saved themselves. Out of 18 workers who were injured, 10 received minor injuries and were discharged from the hospital the same day, two are still in the hospital but six workers received fatal injuries.

(c) and (d). Compensation in this case is payable by the contractor directly to the labourers or their heirs as may be decided by the Chief Labour Commissioner. The CPWD has sent an intimation about the accident to the Chief Labour Commissioner. Should the contractor fail to make payment to the labourers or their heirs, the CPWD, when called upon by the Chief Labour Commissioner, can deduct such amounts as directed by the Chief Labour Commissioner from the dues payable to the contractor for the work executed by him.

TEAM SENT TO YUGOSLAVIA FOR STUDYING THE SYSTEM OF COMMUNES

<a) whether a team has been sent to study the system, of communes in Yugoslavia;

(b) if so, what is the composition of the team; and

(c) whether the team was officially invited by the Government of Yugoslavia?

THE PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARY TO THE MINISTER OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND COOPERATION (SHRI S. D. MISRA): (a) Yes.

(b) The team consists of—

1. Shri B. Mehta, IAS, (Leader) Chief Secretary to the Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

2. Shri G. F. Mankodi, IAS, Commissioner (Panchayats), Ministry of Community Development & Co-operation, New Delhi.

(c)- No. The team was sponsored by this Ministry in pursuance of the agreement entered into with the Ford Foundation some time back for such purposes.

FORD FOUNDATION GRANTS FOR FAMILY PLANNING EDUCATION IN INDIA

85. SHRI S. PANIGRAHI: Will the Minister of HEALTH be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that some grants have been made by the Ford Foundation for the purpose of family planning education in India;

(b) if so, what is the total amount of grant; and

(c) how this amount is going to be spent for family planning in all the States?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH (SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) \$ 3,30,000,00.

(c) The amount granted by the Ford Foundation is intended mainly for the following schemes:—

(1) Provision of 5 Family Planning Action-Cum-Research Centres;

(2) Provision of fund for assisting small research projects mainly in the Departments of Social Sciences and Universities;

(3) (a) Provision of 10 fellowships for post-graduate studies abroad, and

(b) Fellowships in India for training at the All India Institute of Hygiene and Public Health.

(4) Provision of experts in the Ford Foundation office in Delhi.
