KOYNA HYDRO-ELECTRIC PROJECT

- *475. MOULANA M. FARUQI: Will the Minister of Irrigation and Power be pleased to state:
- (a) what progress has so far been made with regard to the implementation of the Koyna Hydro-electric 'Project; and
- (b) by what time the project is scheduled to be fully implemented?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (SHRI J. S. L. HATHI): (a) and (b). A statement giving the requisite information is laid on the Table of the Sabha.

STATEMENT

(a) The progress of the more important items of work on the Koyna Hydro-Electric Project as on 31st October, 1959 is given below:

I. Dam and Appurtenances

Excavation to the extent of 22.4 m. cft. in over-burden and in rock has been completed. This constitutes 73.00 per cent, of the total estimated excavation to be done.

Concreting to the extent of 8.914 m.cft. has been done. This constitutes 24.46 per cent. of the total concreting work.

II. Underground Excavation

- (1) Race Tunnels.—Excavation work on both the Head Race Tunnel and Tail Race Tunnel has been completed.
- (2) Pressure Shafts.—Excavation work on Pressure Shaft No. I has been completed whereas in the case of Shaft No. II, it has been done to the extent of 1650 Rft. leaving 370 Rft. to be done.
- (3) Cable Tunnel.—1,244 Rft. of excavation work was done in the Cable Tunnel. This constitutes 51.30 per cent. of the total work to be done.

- (4) Power House.—Against a total estimated quantity of 6.981 m.cft., excivation to the extent of 5.1928 m.cft. has been completed in the Power House. This constitutes 74.39 per cent. of the total excavation to be done.
- III. Concreting of underground works
- (1) Race Tunnels.—Concreting work of Tail Race Tunnel has commenced during October, 1959.
- (2) Power House.—Concreting to the extent of 3,615 Brass has been completed against a total estimated quautity of 23,890 Brass. This constitutes 15·13 per cent of the total concreting to be done.

The expenditure incurred upto the end of October, 1959 is Rs. 15.80 crores. This works out to a little less than 42 per cent. of the total estimated outlay of Rs. 38:28 crores. The physical achievements, however, work out to a little over 42 per cent.

(b) The first generating unit of 60,000 kw. is scheduled to be commissioned in the last quarter of 1961 and each of the remaining three units of the same capacity at six months' intervals thereafter.

SCARCITY OF DRINKING WATER AT BEHARA RAILWAY STATION

(a) Yes, Sir; some scarcity is felt.

(b) It is proposed, however to extend the existing waiting hall and the work has been approved.

(b) A provision of Rs. 2,000 has been made for the work. Estimate for the work is being sanctioned and the work is expected to be commenced shortly.
