

SHRI JAWAHARLAL NEHRU: It is an internal matter. We do not act internally in India to please or displease other countries.

SHRI D. A. MIRZA: May I know, Sir, why no action is taken against the anti-Indian propaganda that is being carried on by our own people in our country?

SHRIMATI LAKSHMI MENON: Because of the constitutional principles,

SHRI D. A. MIRZA: Then, Sir, may I know this? We are able to take steps to check anti-Indian propaganda in a foreign country. In our own country, we are not able to do it. May I know the reason for it? In a foreign country, we are able to do it, in Cairo and other places. In our own country, may I know why our own Government is not able to put down the anti-Indian propaganda that is carried on by the Communist Party of India?

SHRI JAWAHARLAL NEHRU: The hon. Member is not correctly informed.

SHRI N. M. LINGAM: Is not Government aware that this anti-national stand taken by individual members of the Communist Party and by the Party itself is being exploited by the Chinese Government, to its advantage? So, do not Government propose to take action against such propaganda in view of such developments?

SHRI JAWAHARLAL NEHRU: Government is aware that use is made of these statements, etc. made in India by individuals or groups or parties, to our disadvantage.

SHRIMATI YASHODA REDDY: The hon. Deputy Minister said the Government does not intend taking action. That means they are not taking action. When a Party in India itself is doing so much damage which is more harmful than outside damage, why don't the Government intend taking action even if they do not take action?

SHRI JAWAHARLAL NEHRU: It is a fine distinction.

SALE OF CHINESE MAP SHOWING SINO-INDIAN BORDER

*21. SHRI JUGAL KISHORE: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is fact that Chins is putting on public sale copies o.' a sketch map of the Sino-Indiar frontier showing Indian and Chinese versions of the border line and also the McMahon Line and marked points where Indian troops were alleged to have intruded into China; and

(b) what steps Government are taking to meet this propaganda oi China?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OH EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRIMATI LAKSHMI MENON): (a) and (b). Gov-ernment have seen maps published in Chinese newspapers and magazines, alleging Indian intrusions into Chinese territory. Government have issued maps of Northern Sector of India clarifying India's northern frontier as recognised by us and also indicating Chinese intrusions into India. The maps have since been published.

SHRI JUGAL KISHORE' May I know, Sir, since when and at what price and in which places these maps are sold?

SHRIMATI LAKSHMI MENON: The map was published on the 3rd October in the newspapers.
