(a) how many underwriting* of issues had been undertaken by the Industrial Finance Corporation in 1959; and

(b) what are the names of the companies and what is the commission earned on that account?

THE MINISTER OF REVENUE AND CIVIL EXPENDITURE (DR. B. GOPALA REDDI): (a) and (b). So far, during the year 1959, the Industrial Finance Corporation has underwritten one issue of Preference shares of Messrs. Khandelwal Ferro Alloys Limited, Bombay. The amount of commission earned on this account is Rs. 93,750.

(b) Pig iron and steel produced by Bhilai will be distributed among the users according to the allocations made by the Government from time to time.

Items for the Centenary Celebrations in 1961 are in various stages of preparation: chief among them are publications of Tagore's works, construction of theatres in State Capitals, organization of exhibitions, dramatic performances and seminars in India and abroad.

ESTABLISHMENT OF INDUSTRIAL ESTATES IN INDIAN UNIVERSITIES

24. SHRI MAHESWAR NAIK: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Government of India have decided to equip certain Universities in India with industrial estate facilities on the basis of "earning while learning";

(b) if so, what are the details of the scheme; and

(c) in which of the Universities and at what cost the scheme is proposed to be given effect to?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (DR. K. L. SHRIMALI) : (a) to (c). A statement is attached.

STATEMENT

The details of the scheme at present envisaged as an experimental measure are as follows; modifications may, however, have to be made in the course of actual working: —

The University Grants Commission and the Ministry of Commerce and Industry have been examining for some time the feasibility of establishing Industrial Estates, attached to Universities, with 4 or 5 units of small industries suited to the conditions and circumstances of each University and designed to achieve the following broad objects: —

(a) to weaken the tendency on the part of all University and college students to work for "white collar" jobs and predispose some of them towards skilled work;
