(a) India was approached first to serve as a rotating member and now as a permanent member.

(b) (i) During the International Geophysical Year, the precision Optical-Satellite Tracking Camera was set up by the U.P. State Observatory at Naini Tal in cooperation with Smithsonian Institute of America to track with precision artificial earth satellites.

(ii) Radio Transmissions of Satellite Signals are being received occasionally by several scientific and technological organizations in India.

(iii) For several years the upper regions of the atmosphere and portion of the outer space have been studied by using variable frequency earth based transmitters.
