SHRI M. V. KRISHNAPPA: We have taken the least amount. We have not taken the maximum amount of food which can be produced. I am giving you the estimate on the basis of State figures. The additional food production from land reclaimed by C. T. O. by the end of 1958-59—Operational season—was of the value of Rs. 48.9 crores, at the rate of Rs. 300 per ton.

**UNITED NATIONS EVALUATION MISSION
ON COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**

*394. **SHRI HARIHAR PATEL:** Will the Minister of COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND CO-OPERATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether the first United Nations Evaluation Mission on Community Development has submitted its report; and

(b) if so, what are the main features of the report and what are the recommendations contained therein?

THE PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARY TO THE MINISTER OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND CO-OPERATION (SHRI S. D. MISRA):

(a) Not yet.

(b) Does not arise.

SHRI HARIHAR PATEL: May I know, Sir, when is the Report likely to be submitted?

SHRI S. D. MISRA: Very soon.

SHRI RAJENDRA PRATAP SINHA: Cannot he define it more correctly?

SHRI B. S. MURTHY: The mission left India in March, 1959. It is more than five months now and therefore we are expecting the report at any time.

**COMET IV OF THE BRITISH OVERSEAS
AIRWAYS CORPORATION**

*395. **SHRI S. C. DEB:** Will the Minister of TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Comet IV of the British Overseas Airways Corporation met with an accident while landing at Dum Dum airport on Monday, the 8th June, 1959;

(b) if so, what was the nature of the accident and what was the extent of loss, if any, incurred because of that accident; and

(c) whether any investigation has been made in the matter?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI AHMED MOHIUDDIN): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The aircraft got bogged while landing under poor weather conditions. No one was injured, but the aircraft sustained substantial damage.

(c) Yes, Sir.

SHRI S. C. DEB: May I know, Sir, the result of the investigation?

SHRI AHMED MOHIUDDIN: The Report has been submitted to the Government and it will be placed in the Parliament Library in due course.

SHRI S. C. DEB: May I know, Sir, whether any preliminary report as to why this service was bogged is there?

SHRI AHMED MOHIUDDIN: The report is still a confidential document and we cannot release it unless we agree to a date for releasing it with the Government where this aircraft is registered. That is the international convention.

SHRI RAJENDRA PRATAP SINHA: May I know, Sir, if the hon. Minister is aware of the length of the runway for a jet plane? Can he give us that figure?

SHRI AHMED MOHIUDDIN: The length of the runway was quite suitable for the Comet to land.
