

SHRI ABHIMANYU RATH: Are those third-class coaches also air-conditioned?

SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN: No air-conditioning. We have taken out the air-conditioned coach and replaced it by three non-air-conditioned third class coaches.

DR. A. N. BOSE: Is it a fact that a large number of tourists have been travelling along this route since the starting of the steel plant and other industrial projects here, and if that is so, does not the hon. Minister think that the introduction of a de-luxe train here might relieve the pressure on this tourist traffic and also help us in earning some foreign exchange?

SHRI SHAH NAWAZ KHAN: As I have just explained, physically it is not possible. It is impossible, for there is no line capacity. We are running a lot of goods trains and we find it difficult enough.

श्री नवानसिंह चौहान : क्या मंत्री जी यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि उनके साथ जो डिसकशन हुआ वह किन चीजों पर हुआ और उस डिसकशन के बाद क्या आप किसी निर्णय पर पहुंचे?

श्री एस० डी० मिश्र : जी, हां, एक बार्टर ऐग्रीमेंट के सम्बन्ध में डिसकशन हुआ। यहां से कुछ माल लेने के सम्बन्ध में और वहां से कुछ माल देने के सम्बन्ध में बार्त एंहुई और एक ऐग्रीमेंट भी ड्राफ्ट किया गया।

श्री नवानसिंह चौहान : क्या उस ऐग्रीमेंट की दो चार खास-खास बातें आप बताने की कृपा करेंगे।

श्री एस० डी० मिश्र : जी हां, उसमें दोनों कोआपरेटिव यूनियनों के जरिए कुछ चीजें जैसे जूते, जूट बैग्स, टुबैको, आदि यहां से जायेंगी और कुछ चीजें जैसे रेफ्रिजरेटर्स, अमूनियम सलफेट, ऐग्रीकल्चरल इम्प्लीमेंट्स आदि वहां से आयेंगी। यह एग्रीमेंट एक साल के लिए हुआ है और इस पर ८ अप्रैल को साइन हुये।

श्री पा० ना० राजभोज : क्या मंत्री जी बतायेंगे कि दूसरे राष्ट्र की ओर से किसी को सरकार ने बुलाया है या नहीं?

PROFESSOR OF PATHOLOGY IN LADY  
HARDINGE MEDICAL COLLEGE

\*394. SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA: Will the Minister of HEALTH be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Professor of Pathology in the Lady

Hardinge Medical College applied for leave preparatory to retirement;

(b) whether subsequently she applied for the cancellation of her leave;

(c) whether the post was advertised and the selection committee did not find a suitable candidate for the post; and

(d) whether they recommended that the present Professor of Pathology be recalled?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH (SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR): (a) and (b). Yes, Sir.

(c) and (d). The post was advertised and out of the four candidates interviewed, one was considered suitable for the post.

The Chairman and some members of the Selection Committee, however, bearing in mind the needs of the Maulana Azad Medical College, considered that the previous Lady Professor of Pathology might be permitted to return. This was given due consideration, but in the interests of the institution it was decided not to recall her from leave.

SHRI M. P. BHARGAVA: May I know the reasons why a male Professor of Pathology is preferred against the recommendation of the selection committee for recalling the present incumbent?

SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR: Sex was no reason at all which came up in the final decision.

DR. R. P. DUBE: How long has she been there in that institution? You say now that it is not in the interests of the institution to continue her.

SHRI D. P. KARMARKAR: She retired at the period for normal retirement. She is now on leave preparatory to retirement and, to the extent possible, she has been given the advantage of refused leave also. She has not retired at a period earlier than the normal period of retirement.
