- (a) whether surveys have been made by the Railway Administration for:
  - (i) the Ahmedabad—Asarwa— Kapadwanj railway line;
  - (ii) the Kandla-Viramgam broad gauge railway line; and
  - (iii) the Tardpur-Bhavnagar railway line; and
- (b) if so, what is the length of these lines and what will be their cost?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF RAIL-WAYS (SHRI S. V. RAMASWAMY):

- (a) Yes Sir;
  - (i) in 1927-28;
  - (ii) in 1947-48;
  - (iii) in 1956-57.
  - (b) Lengths are:
    - (i) 33.5 miles;
    - (ii) 152.4 miles;
    - (iii) 87.5 miles.

As regards costs, fresh Surveys and Estimates will have to be carried out for items (i) and (ii). For item (iii),

the Abstract Estimate is Rs. 8 crores, but the figure is likely to go up.

## MACARONI

- \*551. Shri P. A. SOLOMON: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:
- (a) the total quantity of macaroni produced in India in the year 1958; and
- (b) whether any propaganda has so far been organised by Government to popularise macaroni among the people; and if so, what are the results of such propaganda?

THE MINISTER OF FOOD AND AGRI-CULTURE (SHRI A. P. JAIN): It is understood that the Central Food Technological Research Institute which is under the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research produced 100 tons. Information about other sources is not available.

(b) The Central Food Technological Research Institute, Mysore, had organised propaganda in Kerala State in collaboration with the State Government to popularise Macaroni. Institute has published the results in a bulletin. Reports available indicate that the product was generally acceptable.
