D_R . MONO MOHAN DAS: These amounts will be part of the expenditure that has to be incurred by the National Physical Laboratory for the running of their department. It is simply the maintenance of the equipment and their running.

MR. CHAIRMAN: Dr. Das, all these things should have been put along with the statement. You read the question. You should answer (b), (c) and (d).

Dr. MONO MOHAN DAS: Yes, Sir.

SHRI NAWAB SINGH CHAUHAN: लास्ट पैराग्राफ में जो "Broadcasting time signals at 10 stations" है, तो ये जो दस स्टेशंस है इन में क्या फर्क है? क्या ये एक ही सा टाइम ब्राडकास्ट करते हैं और क्या हिन्दुस्तान में जो ब्राडकास्ट होगा क्या उसी के ग्रनुसार होगा ?

COMPULSORY RETIREMENT OR SUPER-ANNUATION IN INCOME-TAX DEPART-MENT, WEST BENGAL, CALCUTTA

*363. SHRI Z. A. AHMAD: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether there have been any cases of compulsory retirement or superannuation in the Income-Tax Department, West Bengal, Calcutta;

(b) if so, the number of such cases;

(c) whether in all such cases of retirement the length of service of each employee was taken into consideration;

(d) whether break of service in the Income-Tax Department by these retired persons had been condoned for ca culation of pensions; and

(e) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER OF FIN-ANCE (SHRI B R BHAGAT): (a) There has been no case of compulsory retirement as a measure of penalty, but there have been cases of retirement on superannuation.

The age of superannuation is 55 years except in the case of Class IV Staff in whose case it is 60 Ministerial Government Servants holding lien on permanent posts on or before 31st March, 1938, can also be retained upto the age of 60 years provided they continue to be efficient and fit.

(b) to (e). Does not arise so far as compulsory retirement is concerned. Regarding retirement on superannuation the question does not specify the period for which information is required However, information in respect of one year (57-58) is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House in due course.
