Each University was asked to recommend a maximum of six persons representing different fields of university education—one each from Humanities, Social Sciences, Natural Sciences, Psychometrics, Education and Administration—directly connected with the conduct of university examinations. A selection committee comprising Secretary and Joint Secretary of Ministry of Education; Director, India Wheat Loan Educational Exchange Programme; a representative of the University Grants Commission and Dr. Tara Chand, M.P. was constituted to select ten suitable persons from the names recommended by the various Universities. The members of the team were selected on merit, keeping in view the fact that at least one person should be taken from each of fields of study mentioned above, and that the persons so selected should be senior enough to have some say in the affairs of the University concerned.

3. The team will be returning to India in two batches. The first batch consisting of the persons mentioned at Serial Nos. 1—6 in paragraph 1 above will leave the U.S.A. on 21st December 1958. The remaining four will leave the U.S.A. on 21st January, 1959.]

THE MINISTER OF FINANCE (SHRI MORARJI R. DESAI): (a) and (b). The estimates prepared by the Reserve Bank of India give overall figures of foreign exchange earned by Government on account of tourist travel on the basis of broad estimates of the number of tourists who visited or are expected to visit India and the average amount which each is likely to have spent or to spend. They do not classify the transactions according to the different categories of tourists. The information required in the question is, therefore, not available.
