f[SETTING UP OF POST-BASIC INSTITUTIONS

*591. SHRI NAWAB SINGH CHAUHAN: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to refer to page 8 of the Report of the Ministry of Education and Scientific Research for 1957-58 and State :

(a) the number of State Governments which have so far set up Post-Basic Institutions and the number of such institutions so far set up by each of them; and

(b) the amount of financial assistance so far given by the Central Government to each State Government?]

{क) केवल राजस्थान में एक ।

(ख) ११,००० रुपये ।

K. L. SHRIMALI : (a) One in Ttjasthan only.

(b) Rs. 11,000.]

डा० के० एल० श्रीमाली : इसका अलावा मैं आपसे यह निवेदन करना चाहता हूँ कि कुछ रियासतों के रिप्रेजेंटेशन भी हमारे पास आए हैं, जिन पर विचार किया जा रहा है । इस स्कीम को कार्यरूप में परिणत करने में इसलिए देरी हुई है कि क्योंकि फ इन्स कमिटी से दो तीन साल पहले ही स्वीकृति हुई है और अब जो बाकी प्रपोजल आये हैं, उन पर विचार किया जा रहा है ।

I might also explain it in English, Sir. There has been some delay in sanctioning this scheme by the Finance Committee. Now the scheme has been sanctioned and there are certain proposals by the Madras State and Bihar State, which are under consideration. Some applications have also been received from voluntary organisations, and necessary action will be taken.

श्री नवाबसिंह चौहान : क्या यह सच है कि सरकार इस बेसिक शिक्षा को जब अपनी शिक्षा पद्धति का एक मुख्य अंग मानती है, तो क्या कारण है कि सरकार उसके ऊपर शीघ्र से शीघ्र अमल करने का प्रयत्न नहीं करती ?

डा० के० एल० श्रीमाली : इसको स्वीकार कर लिया गया है, इसमें कोई दो राय नहीं है । पोस्ट बेसिक शिक्षा का प्रश्न जो है, वह अलग है । जितने बेसिक स्कूल हैं वे पहले ही स्वीकार हो चुके हैं । पोस्ट बेसिक शिक्षा के बारे में भी सहायता देने के प्रश्न पर विचार किया गया है और चूंकि स्कीम की मंजूरी में कुछ देरी हुई, इसलिए अभी तक ग्राण्ट्स वितरण पूरा नहीं हो पाया ।

श्री नवाबसिंह चौहान : क्या यह सच है कि यह स्कीम केन्द्रीय और राज्य सरकारों दोनों के जरिये से चलाई जा सकती है । अगर ऐसा है और यदि राज्य सरकारें न चलायें तो केन्द्रीय सरकार इस स्कीम को क्यों नहीं चलाती ?

डा० के० एल० श्रीमाली : जिम्मेदारी जो राज्य सरकारों की है, केन्द्र की कोई जिम्मेदारी नहीं है। केन्द्र शिक्षा की प्रत्येक श्रेणी पर राज्य सरकारों को सहायता कर रहा है; चूंकि यह समझा गया है कि यह एक आवश्यक स्कीम है, इसके लिए भी सहायता दी जाय।

श्री नवाबसिंह चौहान : केन्द्रीय सरकार दिल्ली में जो केन्द्रीय बेसिक स्कूल खोलने जा रही है उसका क्या हुआ ?

डा० के० एल० श्रीमाली : अभी उस पर विचार किया जा रहा है।

SHRI T. S. AVINASHILINGAM CHETTIAR: May I know, Sir, whether the Government is aware that not even one university has recognised the post-basic schools for purposes of admitting the students turned out by such schools to the university course and as such these post-basic schools do not attract students? Will the Government get these preliminaries settled before investing large amounts of money in starting new post-basic schools?

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DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: This matter was considered at the Ministers' Conference and it was decided that post-basic schools should not be a separate category by itself, that it should be one of the types of multi-purpose schools and that the boys should be able to appear for the same examination. It is not our intention that there should be two parallel streams even at the post-basic school stage.

SHRI T. S. AVINASHILINGAM CHETTIAR: If that is the decision, Sir, what is the reason for having separate Schemes for this? These schemes can be made part of the Secondary Education Scheme so that any further difficulty does not continue?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: The idea is that the same ideology and the same outlook which exist in basic schools might be continued at a later stage

also and that in the content and in the examinations there should not be any separation.

SHRI T. S. AVINASHILINGAM CHETTIAR: May I know, Sir, whether any State Government has implemented this proposal, which had been approved by the last Central Advisory Board of Education? Not even one to my knowledge.

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: At present as far as my knowledge goes, there are 66 post-basic schools in various States including Assam, Bihar, Bombay, Kerala, Madras, Orissa, Punjab, Rajasthan, West Bengal, Andhra Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh, and we are making every effort to see that these schools are integrated into the national system.

SHRI T. S. AVINASHILINGAM CHETTIAR: Pending this integration, Sir, may I know whether the grants for these separate schools will be stopped because that will lead to wastage and blind alleys, I mean whether they will keep these schemes pending?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: I do not share the views of the hon. Member in this matter.

श्री राम सहाय : क्या मैं जान सकता हूँ कि पोस्ट बेसिक इंस्टीट्यूशन और बेसिक स्कूल के अध्ययन में सिद्धान्त तथा पद्धत के आधार पर कुछ भिन्नता है ?

डा० के० एल० श्रीमाली : जी, हाँ। सिद्धान्त एक है। सिद्धान्त में कोई विशेष मतभेद नहीं है।

SHRI H. N. KUNZRU: The Education Minister said that it would be his effort to integrate the post-basic institutions with the national system of education. Would he mind clearly explaining what he meant by this?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: Well, Sir, I was referring to the decision which the Government had taken in consultation with the Education Ministers

of the different States, that these post-basic schools should not form a separate category by themselves, that they should be one of the types of the multi-purpose schools. It is not intended that there should be separate examinations for the students who are going out of the post-basic schools. At the secondary stage there will not be two parallel streams; there will be only one stream and one type of examination.

DR. RAGHUBIR SINH: Why is it not going to be different from the other system?

DR. K. L. SHRIMALI: The hon. Member is aware that basic school has a certain ideology. They give great emphasis on crafts and on manual work and manual activities, and if certain schools want to emphasise that aspect even in secondary schools, Government has no objection; in fact they would welcome that feature in the secondary schools also.

tt SELECTION OF PERSONS FROM JAMMU AND KASHMIR TO ALL-INDIA SERVICES

*592. SHRI RAM SAHAI: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state the number of persons from the State of Jammu and Kashmir who have so far been selected for recruitment to the All-India Services?]

गृह-कार्य मंत्री (श्री गोविन्द बल्लभ पन्त) : आल इण्डिया सर्विसेज में जम्मू और काश्मीर राज्य से अब तक १६ अफसर आई० ए० एस० और ११ आई० पी० एस० के लिये चुने गये हैं।

t[THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI GOVIND BALLABH PANT) : The number of officers from the State of Jammu and Kashmir who have so far been Selected for recruitment to the All-India Services is 16 for the I.A.S, and 11 for the I.P.S.]

श्री राम सहाय : क्या माननीय मंत्री जी बतलाने की कृपा करेंगे कि वहाँ जो आल इण्डिया सर्विसेज के आदमी हैं उनको जम्मू और काश्मीर छोड़ कर इधर भारतवर्ष में और इधर के अधिकारियों को जम्मू और काश्मीर में ट्रांसफर किया गया है ?

श्री गोविन्द बल्लभ पन्त : अभी इस सवाल पर गौर हो रहा है। वहाँ के कुछ लोग अण्डर ट्रेनिंग हैं जो इन सर्विसेज में लिये गये हैं।

SHRI B. K. P. SINHA: May I know, Sir, whether the officers who have been selected, have been selected after interview by a selection board, or have they competed at the All-India Services Examinations?

SHRI GOVIND BALLABH PANT: Their cases have been considered by a selection board presided over by a Member of the Union Public Service Commission.

SHRI B. K. P. SINHA: May I know, Sir, if it is the intention of Government to allot henceforth a certain proportion of the candidates who compete at the All-India Combined Services Examinations to the State of Jammu and Kashmir also?

SHRI GOVIND BALLABH PANT: Yes, the scheme applies to Jammu and Kashmir as to other States.

PANDIT S. S. N. TANKHA: I wanted to know whether this selection has taken place on the basis of an examination or on an ad hoc basis.

SHRI GOVIND BALLABH PANT: No examination was held. Persons who are promoted to the L.A.S. and I.P.S. from among the members of State Service have not to appear in any examination
