minary technical report with regard to the damage done and with regard to the works they have undertaken and the costs involved thereon.

Shri PERATH NARAYANAN NAIR: May I know if the Government is examining the question of sea erosion in Kerala from the point of view of the danger to our defence establishments on that coast also?

SHRI RAJ BAHADUR: Sir, that is a matter for the Ministry of Irrigation and Power. We are concerned with the western road.

Shri N. M. LINGAM: Have Government considered the possibility of changing the alignment of the road in view of the prohibitive cost of preventing sea-erosion affecting this highway?

Shri RAJ BAHADUR: That will be a matter for expert advice and it is only on that advice that we can come to a decision if any change in the alignment of the road is necessary.
