# **TOURIST INFORMATION OFFICE IN GUJRAT-SAURASHTRA REGION**

14. SHRI J. H. JOSHI: Will the Minister of TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state whether

Government propose to open a tourist information office in any part of the Gujrat-Saurashtra region?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI RAJ BAHADUR): A Tourist Information Office established at Rajkot with effect from 9-12-1955 by the former State of Saurashtra is being run by the Government of Bombay. A non-official Tourist Association has been organised in Ahmedabad. This Association has opened a tourist information bureau the cost of which is being shared equally between the Central and the State Governments. The State Government propose to make similar arrangements at Mangleshwar (Broach District).

Apart from the Government of India Tourist Office in Bombay, the area of jurisdiction of which includes Gujrat-Saurashtra region, no other tourist office directly managed by the Centre is proposed to be opened in this region.
