- (c) Not opening of Savings Bank Accounts in respec Teachers' 1 rovident Fund in the Post Offices though the amount of Provident Fund was being deducteď from their salaries.
- (c) and (d). The Delhi Corporation has intimated that salaries of the teachers of the Vedic Hindi Middle School, Kotla Mubarakpur, Jain Girls Middle School, Jangpura and Saini Pathshala, Rashtriya Kanya Pahari Dhiraj, Delhi have been paid up to the

31st March, 1958 and the salaries of the teachers of Veer Kanya Pathshala will be paid in a week's time.

The Corporation has been asked to release the grants-in-aid to the maining schools immediately and persuade the managements of the schools to pay the salaries of their teachers if they have not already done so.
